I would like to object to granting this application for the following reasons:

- 1) Without drilling test wells there is no way to absolutely determine that drilling a well in Mormon Wells will not affect the surface water flow in Beaver Dam Wash. I feel a complete study should be done at the applicants expense with test holes and an invironmental study should be done before even considering this application.
- 2) It is stated that Arizona residents will be served first however, who would monitor the water, how often and would we be allowed to continue growing?
- 3) The application states that the water would be returned to Arizona however, not back to Beaver Dam, just to a small parcel that the principles in Wind River own and call Vista Verda Water District . The property is currently provided water by Beaver Dam Water and just recently Mohave County took over the Vista Verda Water District. Doesn't this negate the applications claim to provide water back to Arizona?
- 4) In reading the newspaper it has been stated by Virgin Valley Water District that they really don't need the water it is just the last cheap water left. It has also been stated that they have enough water to service 80,000 people and are only supplying water to 14,000 at present. I can't see that the application justifies selling our water to a neighbor that really isn't in need.
- 5) Selling our water would stifle growth, limit Arizona Tax base and deny residents any long term future in this area.
